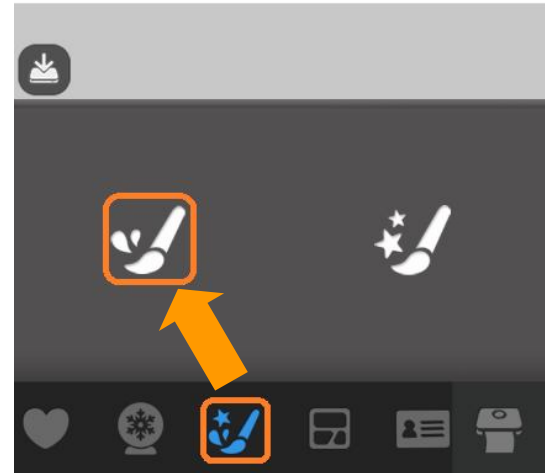
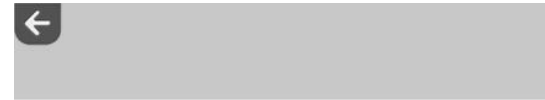
# Advance Play – Make Background



1. Choose the blank photo available in the Pringo album in your phone, or a random photo

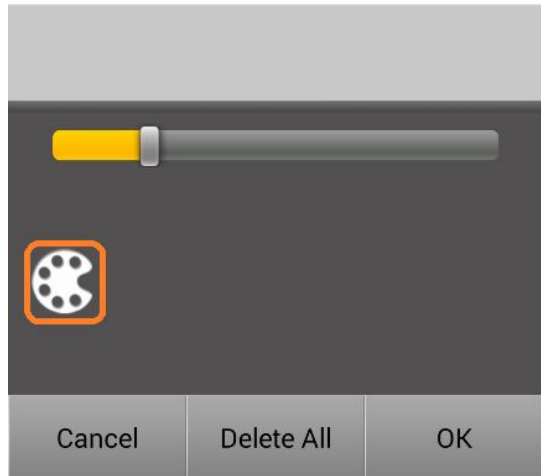
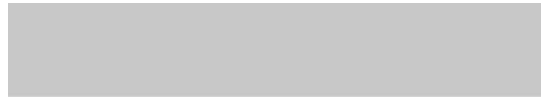


2. Drag the photo out of the editing section so that you have a blank page

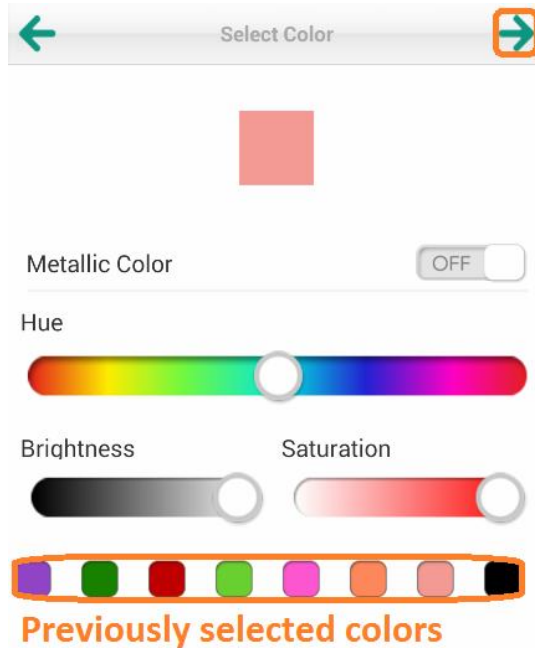


3. Tap on the Brush function and tap on Paintbrush

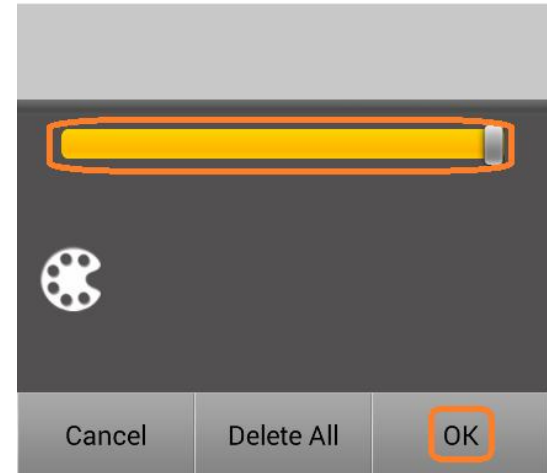

4. Tap on the Palette icon to choose color

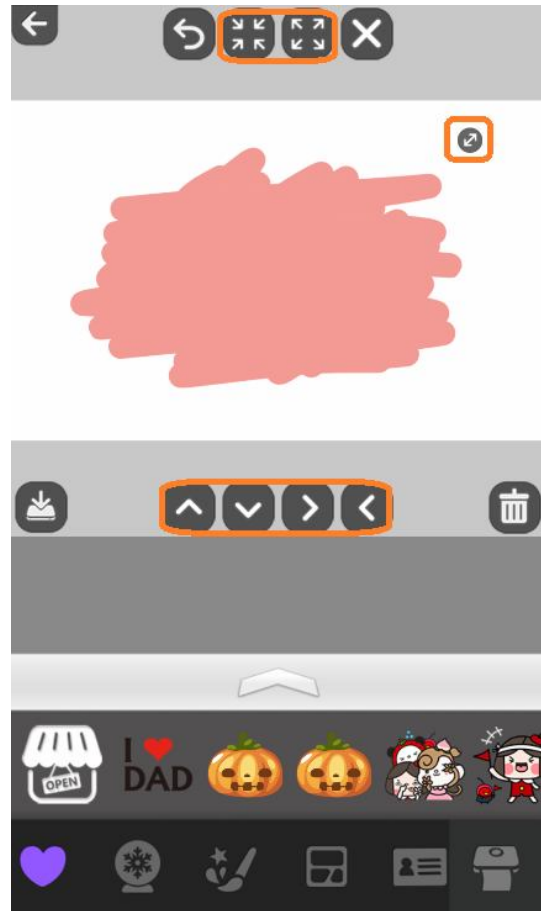


5. Use the Hue, Brightness & Saturation bars to get the color you desire and tap →

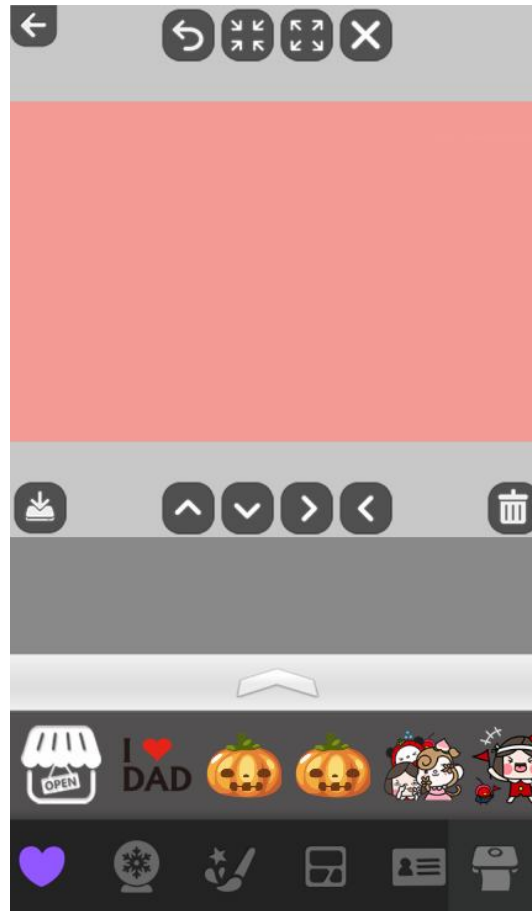


6. Use the bar to adjust brush thickness. Paint a rough rectangular shape – you do not have to fill the whole page

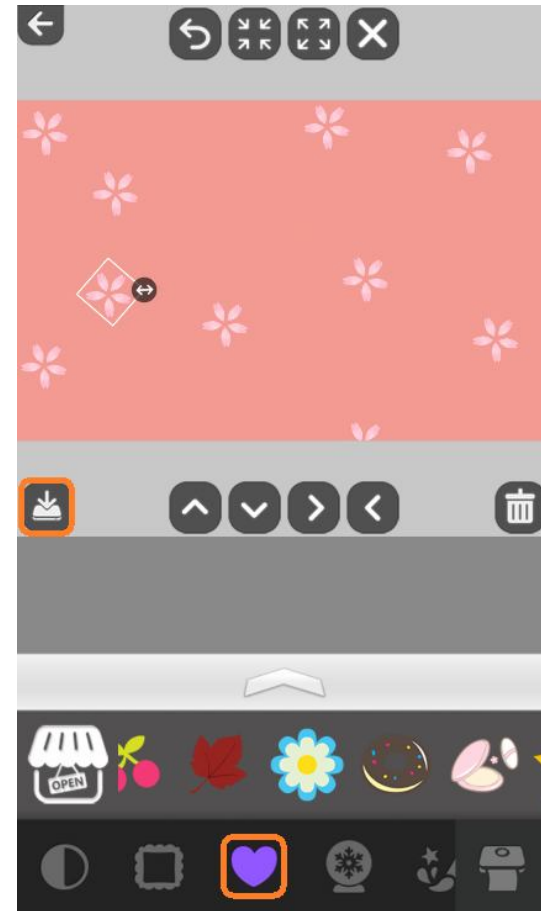
